

WILLIS BURGLARY.

SYDNEY, Monday.—In an interview regarding the recent attempted burglary at his house, Mr. W. N. Willis said his wife and children had been greatly terrified at the latest outrage occurring so soon after the previous attempt on his life that he has now made up his mind to send them out of the country.

"I have written to Mrs. Willis' trustees," he said, "asking them to consent to her selling her interests here and proceeding with her children to England. I myself will stop here and fight the matter out. I have made a promise to the public that the plain, unvarnished facts attendant on the land scandals will be made known, and I have been at work for some time writing a book in which I shall make those revelations. So far I have kept absolutely secret what I have written and placed it in a safe, to open which an attempt was made."
